

# Proposed Methamphetamine Regulations for Rental Housing

A concise summary of the Government's proposal to regulate testing, thresholds and decontamination for meth residue in rental homes.

## **Key Thresholds**

- 15  $\mu$ g/100 cm<sup>2</sup>: at or above this level, areas are considered contaminated and require decontamination.
- 30  $\mu$ g/100 cm<sup>2</sup>: at or above this level, either party may end the tenancy via the specified notice process.

## **Testing Pathway**

- Screening to check if detailed testing is needed.
- Detailed testing by qualified, independent professionals.

#### **Decontamination**

Where results exceed 15 µg/100 cm<sup>2</sup>, decontamination must be carried out and the property re-tested to confirm compliance.

### **Rights & Responsibilities**

- Clear duties for landlords when contamination is identified.
- Protection for tenants' health and certainty on habitability.

#### **Timeline**

Regulations are expected to come into force in 2026 (date TBC).
